





Considering the importance of the financial literacy of the beneficiaries, IFS has taken steps to implement a project to raise the level of financial literacy.


Significant research is being done in the frame of the project due to which the target group needing training will be revealed and individual programs will be developed for each group to make the educational process more efficient.

IFS is open to collaboration with other projects and non-profits relating to our beneficiaries. The war has been a stimulus for creating of a number of non-profits which along with providing medical and social support also organize various educational projects. We have established relations with both newly founded and experienced non-profits. As a result of discussions and meetings we have signed memorandums of collaboration basing on common interests.

## DONATIONS BY CURRENCY

During the reporting period 544.8 million AMD has been collected from donations, where 57% (311.5 million AMD) in Armenian Drams. The donations in the USD are 36% (equivalent to 194 million AMD). The donations in Rubles and Euros make 3% (equivalent to 17 million AMD) and 4% (equivalent to 22.5 million AMD), respectively.

## **FUNDRAISING CAMPAIGNS**

The following campaigns have been organized during the reporting period:

- In a joint initiative with the Megerian Carpet Company a carpet is being weaved where each knot is a
  donation equivalent to 1,000 AMD. Our Diaspora compatriots can make a donation by means of a
  virtual knot. After the carpet is weaved it will be sold in a charitable auction, where all proceeds will
  be directed to IFS. More than 5 million AMD donations have already been made in the frame of the
  campaign.
- In the frame of the Diaspora Outreach Initiative visits to the largest Armenian communities of the USA were made to create awareness about the IFS and establish relations with prominent organizations and communities. IFS staff visited ten cities in the frame of the Initiative.

  - \$50.000 largest lump-sum donation;
  - X4 four-fold growth of donations received through the American partner of ISF AWHF: \$16.8 thousand in November as compared to \$3.8 thousand in October.
  - 18+ articles, interviews, lives with IFS. Work in progress;
  - Exhibition-sale of paintings to be organized by the Consulate General of Armenia in Los Angeles. All revenues will be directed to IFS;
  - · Creating and securing trust and awareness;
  - · Establishing links and cooperation with mass media.

A joint online panel with the donors, audience interested in the IFS activities and IFS beneficiaries during which IFS staff presented the mission of IFS, its accountability, the work carried out after the recent war. The beneficiaries presented their stories which were followed by questions from the audience.

As a result of established new connections 3 different fundraising campaigns in Boston, Los Angeles and New York will be organized in the near future.
